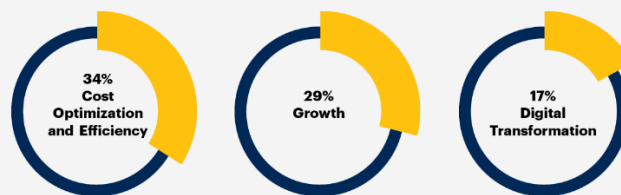

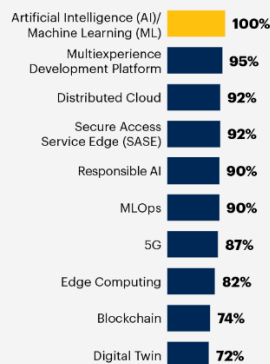

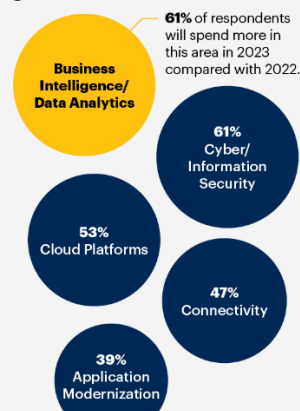

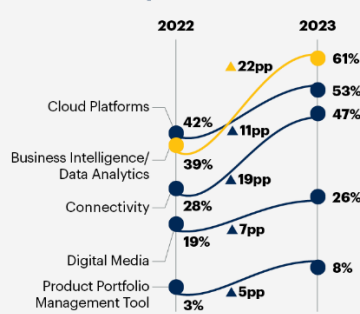

Overview

Most CSPs and enterprises will readjust their strategy as a response to the triple squeeze of economic pressure, scarce expensive talent and supply challenges. How do you ensure that you aren't trading off digital acceleration as a result?

For most CSPs, this is the time to shape their business and operating model. As they plan and execute on the strategic goals of business and operating model transformation, the triple squeeze, particularly economic headwinds, can seriously derail their projects. Therefore, CIOs and technology leaders have an important responsibility to prioritize the right initiatives and balance investments in core capability building projects.

About This Research

2023 Gartner CIO and Technology Executives Survey: This survey was conducted to help CIOs and technology executives overcome digital execution gaps by empowering and enabling an ecosystem of internal and external digital technology producers. It was conducted online from 2 May 2022 through 25 June 2022 among Gartner Executive Programs members and other CIOs.

Qualified respondents are each the most senior IT leader (e.g., CIO) for their overall organization or some part of their organization (for example, a business unit or region). The total sample is 2,203 respondents, with representation from all geographies and industry sectors (public and private), including 40 from communication service providers.
